Anna Stewart was a Victorian union official and campaigner for women’s rights. Sadly, she passed away unexpectedly in 1983 at the age of 35. The Anna Stewart Program was established by union colleagues in her memory to ensure that the needs of working women are recognised and to improve the representation of women in decision-making structures. The Federation maintains the program as an ‘affirmative action’ aimed at developing the skills, knowledge and confidence of women members and empowering them to be actively involved in their workplace, local association, or state level.

To ensure that all women members have an opportunity to participate in the program, the Federation will cover transport and accommodation costs for eligible successful applicants.
